Dear Councilmembers Sims and Grant:

On October 16, 1989, the King County Council adopted Ordinance 9171, which appropriated \$40,000 to the Health and Human Services Set Aside for the County's contribution to the Men Working Against Abuse Program. While I believe that this is a very worthwhile program, I am allowing this Ordinance to lapse into law without my signature.

It is my understanding that this additional appropriation occurred in a Councilinitiated substitute ordinance to a Health and Human Services Set Aside revenuebacked appropriation ordinance that was before the Finance Committee.

While I appreciate your desire to fund needed programs, I think it important for all of us to remember that due to the impact of the recent annexations and incorporations, the Health and Human Service Set Aside has limited resources to take on new programs. In the future, if the Council would like to take action to increase appropriations for new programs, I believe it is important that the proposed increase be discussed with the Department and the Budget Division.
