ORDINANCE NO. **9213**

AN ORDINANCE relating to clerical staffing for the District Court and to the office of presiding judge for the King County District Courts, appropriating \$79,146 to the district courts from the unappropriated Current Expense balance, to provide salary and benefits for the replacement on the bench of the presiding judge of the district courts and to add a clerk to handle workload increased by absorption of City of Algona cases; amending Ordinance 8802, Section 32, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$76,546 to the district courts from unappropriated Current Expense Fund balance, to provide salary and benefits for the replacement on the bench of the presiding judge to allow him/her to carry out the duties of the office of presiding judge and an appropriation of \$2,600 to provide salary and benefits for the addition of a clerk to handle City of Algona cases.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 32, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

DISTRICT COURTS - From the Current Expense Fund balance, there is hereby appropriated to:


PROVIDED THAT:

The district court provide a quarterly report to the council regarding judicial workload. This report should document the amount of time each judge sits on the bench each day and should show average disposition time for each type of case. This report should be presented within 30 days of the end of each quarter.


