ORDINANCE NO **9222**

AN ORDINANCE prescribing 1990 service fees for use of King County owned and operated computer facilities and equipment as provided by King County systems services; amending Ordinance 8751, Sections 2 and 3, and K.C.C. 4.80.020 and 030.


1        SECTION 2: Ordinance 8751, Section 3, is hereby amended to read as


