ORDINANCE NO. **9259**

AN ORDINANCE abolishing the Sewer ULID Construction Fund (Fund 389) and the Wastewater Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund (Fund 447) and repealing Ordinance No. 3521 and Ordinance No. 1822.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


SECTION 1. The funds in the King County Finance Office designated as the "Sewer ULID Construction Fund" and the "Wastewater Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund" are hereby abolished effective January 1, 1990. All assets and liabilities of the Sewer ULID Construction Fund (Fund 389) are transferred to the King County Current Expense Fund (Fund No. 10). All assets and liabilities of the Wastewater Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund (Fund 447) are transferred to the King County ULID Assessment and Revenue Bond Fund (Fund No. 890).

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 3521, passed by the King County Council on December 19, 1977, establishing the Sewer ULID Construction Fund; and Ordinance No. 1822, passed by the King County Council on October 15, 1973, establishing the Wastewater Sewer Operations and Maintenance Fund, are hereby repealed.




