ORDINANCE NO. 9265

AN ORDINANCE authorizing the Harborview Medical Center to complete the design, purchase and installation of replacement radiographic equipment in its emergency trauma center with funds appropriated for that purpose, notwithstanding any ordinance provisions to the contrary.

PREAMBLE:

The emergency trauma center at Harborview accommodates approximately 42,700 patient visits annually. It is not uncommon for the trauma center to have 150-170 patients in a single day. The design, purchase and installation of new radiographic equipment in the trauma center is necessary to replace badly outdated equipment and to increase the safety of severely traumatized patients. The design, purchase and installation of such equipment should occur immediately, notwithstanding the provisions of other ordinances that might otherwise apply, including those related to Harborview Capital Improvement Projects, bidding procedures for public contracts, and the participation of minority and women's business enterprises.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Harborview Medical Center is authorized to proceed immediately with the design, purchase and installation of new radiographic equipment in its emergency trauma center, as described in the program plan and budget attached to this ordinance, using funds appropriated for those purposes, notwithstanding the provisions of any ordinance to the contrary.




