15 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of
17 \$103,425 to CIP Project No. 668294, Ambulatory Care Project, from unallocated
18 bond proceeds of Fund 387.

19 SECTION 2. There is hereby approved and adopted a disappropriation of
20 \$1,037,997 from Project No. 668291, Harborview Bond Program Plan Costs and
21 \$350,000 from Project No. 678293, Harborview Medical Center Site Preparation
22 in Fund 312, Harborview Medical Center Long Range Capital Improvement Plan.

23 SECTION 3. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of
24 \$418,337 to CIP Project D03121, Harborview Bond Administrative Costs 1989,
25 \$656,975 to Project No. 678294, Trauma Center Construction, and \$217,680 to
26 Project No. 678296, Bed Replacement Project, from unallocated bond proceeds in
27 Fund 312.

28 SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 92, Attachments 1 and 2, as
29 amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the
30 following:
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


