ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the organization of the executive branch of county government, establishing a manager position for the office of capital planning and development and a manager position for the open space acquisition office as exempt positions under the key subordinate unit provisions, amending Ordinance 6066 Section 26 as amended and K.C.C. 2.16.100.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6066, Section 26 as amended

and K.C.C. 2.16.100 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Career Service Exemptions.

A. Exemptions from the requirements of the career service personnel system shall be consistent with the provisions of Section 550, and Sections 350.10 and 350.20 of the King County Charter. Key subordinate units, as determined by the county council, and departmental divisions shall be considered to be executive departments and divisions of the administrative office of financial management shall be considered to be administrative offices for the purpose of determining applicability of the charter provisions.

B. Accordingly, directors, managers, and supervisors of departments, divisions, key subordinate units, as determined by the county council and other units of governments as required by law, shall be exempt from the requirements and provisions of the career service personnel system.

2 C. In this regard, the following are determined by
3 the council to be key subordinate units due to the
4 nature of the programs involved and their public policy
5 implications, and appointments thereto shall be subject
6 to confirmation by the council:

7 1. The administrators for the following programs:

- 8 a. Public defense program.
9 b. Civil rights and compliance program.
10 c. Capital planning and development program

11 2. The jail commander, department of adult
12 detention.


13 3. County project coordinators or managers of the

17 c. Open space acquisition project




