ORDINANCE NO. 9275

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date for an election on the question of annexation of the City of SeaTac into the King County Rural Library District and declaring an emergency.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

The City of SeaTac, Washington by Ordinance No. 89-1009, has initiated the proposed annexation and expressed its intent to join the King County Rural Library District, finding that the public interest will be served thereby. Since there is no city-appointed library board, the state librarian has been notified per RCW 27.12.360.

City of SeaTac Ordinance No. 89-1009 does satisfy the provisions of RCW 27.12.010 (5), and 27.12.360 requesting the calling of an election to be held among the qualified voters therein.

The Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District by Resolution No. 1989-8 has concurred with the proposal as submitted on December 11, 1989, all in accordance with RCW 27.12.360.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 6th day of February, 1990 within the City of SeaTac. The ballot proposition shall be in substantially the following form in accordance with RCW 27.12.370:

"Shall the City of SeaTac, Washington be annexed to and be part of the King County Rural Library District?"
