AN ORDINANCE transferring the Division of Bail, Fines and Penalty Collection of the District Court to the Finance Office of Financial Management; repealing Ordinance 4549, Sections 4 and 5 and K.C.C. 2.68.030 and K.C.C.

ORDINANCE NO.

2.68.040; adding a new section to K.C.C. 2.16.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 4549, Sections 4 and 5, and K.C.C.

2.68.030 and K.C.C. 2.68.040 are hereby repealed.

NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is added to K.C.C. 2.16 a new section to read as follows: FINES AND PENALTY COLLECTION

SECTION. There is hereby established the fines and penalty collection section to be responsible for collecting fines and monetary penalties accruing to the county as a result of action taken by the district court. The section shall be administered by the chief accountant of the office of financial management, and shall report directly to the chief accountant. The activities of the section shall be coordinated with the district court and department of public safety. Formal procedures shall be promulgated to insure that such services are provided in conformance with general law and other related policies of the county.
