ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of King County for the year 1990 amending Ordinance 9255, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 9255, Section 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the levies necessary to fund estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:
