ORDINANCE NO. 9316

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Maple Valley Meadows to Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Maple Valley Meadows to Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service was filed with the county council effective January 16, 1990.
- 2. Cedar River Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2687 concurred with the proposed annexation for water service.
- 3. Cedar River Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated November 21, 1989, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the $12^{\frac{th}{h}}$ day of FEBRUARY , 19 90 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service of the area known as Maple Valley Meadows and described in Section 4 herein is approved. proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Maple Valley Meadows.

SECTION 2. Cedar River Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed for water service.
