ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as 315-S to Soos Creek Water and Sewer District for sewer service.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as 315-S to Soos Creek Water and Sewer District for sewer service was filed with the county council effective December 14, 1989.
- 2. Soos Creek Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation for sewer service to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 0391-S concurred with the proposed annexation.
- 3. Soos Creek Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated September 21, 1989, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the 8th day of \_\_\_\_\_\_\_, 1990 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 56.02.060.
- 5. The criterion set forth in RCW 56.02.060(1) requires the council to consider whether the proposed annexation is in compliance with the development program that is outlined in the county comprehensive plan and its supporting documents.
- 6. King County Comprehensive Plan policies F-315 and F-216 provide that sewer service should be extended only to designated urban areas and rural activity centers.
- 7. On July 13, 1989 the county council adopted interim zoning controls for the Soos Creek and Tahoma/Raven Heights Community Planning Areas by ordinance 9044. These controls applied rural area zoning, AR-5-P, within the Soos, Covington and Jenkins Creek Basins for a period of 18 months.

8. The area known as 315-S, proposed for annexation to the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District, is subject to the interim controls and has rural area zoning.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation of Soos Creek Water and Sewer District of the area known as 315-S for sewer service and described in Section 4 herein is denied. This proposed annexation is inconsistent with the King County Comprehensive Plan and R.C.W. 56.02.060(1).

SECTION 2. The area known as 315-S is described as follows:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 26, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., in King County, Washington, said point being on the existing boundary of the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District;

Thence Easterly along the North line of said Southwest quarter, said line also known as the centerline of S.E. 260th Street, to the centerline of Soos Creek Drive S.E.;

Thence Southeasterly along the centerline of Soos Creek Drive S.E. to the North line of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 26;

Thence Easterly along said North line to the East line of the Southwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 26;

Thence Southerly along said East line to the East-West centerline of Section 26, also being the centerline of S.E. 264th Street;

Thence Westerly along said East-West centerline of said Section 26 to the quarter corner common to Section 26 and Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M.;

2	Thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 26, also being the East line of Section 27, Township 22 North, Range 5 East, W.M., to the Point of Beginning.
