ORDINANCE NO. 9351

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$20,000 to the 1989 Recorder's Operation and Maintenance Budget and \$76,475 for the 1990 Recorder's Operation and Maintenance Fund Budget from the Recorder's Operation and Maintenance fund balance to pay for costs incurred in establishing and operating the Recorder's Operation and Maintenance fund to achieve its purposes pursuant to state law; and adding a new Section to Ordinance 8802; and adding a new Section to Ordinance 9221.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$20,000 to the 1989 Recorder's Operation and Maintenance from the Recorder's Operation and Maintenance fund balance to pay for costs incurred in establishing and operating the Recorder's Operation and Maintenance fund to achieve its purposes pursuant to Chapter 204, Laws of Washington, 1989, and an appropriation of \$76,475 to the 1990 Recorder's Operation and Maintenance Fund.

NEW SECTION, SECTION 2. There is hereby added to Ordinance 8802, as amended, a new section to read as follows:
