STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of Northeast 165th Street, heleinafter described.
- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that easements were not required.
- 3. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been opened as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 4. By direction of the Transportation and Public Utilities Committee, the department of public works staff resumed the processing of the previously denied vacation by reissuing notices to utility districts and other agencies who had expressed concerns with the original proposal. Responses to those notices found that the concerns of the utilities had been abated by the petitioners' reduction in the vacation area. The subdivision products section of the building and land development division and the traffic and planning section of the department of public works continue to have concerns with the concept of reducing the right of way width to less than sixty feet.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.
