ORDINANCE NO. **9389**

AN ORDINANCE conditionally approving the City of Black Diamond's 1989 Comprehensive Sewerage Plan.

FINDINGS OF FACT:

In 1987 the City of Black Diamond's alternative sewer treatment plant was declared a failure by the State Environmental Protection Agency.

Engineering studies show that the most cost-effective solution to the City's problem is a connection to Metro's Renton Treatment plant via the Soos Creek Sewer and Water District's pump station. This connection will require that a sewer transmission main be placed in county rights-of-way which are not within the sewer local service area.

A King County approved comprehensive plan is required before a franchise and a right-of-way construction permit are issued to place the transmission main in county rights-of-way.

On April 6, 1989, the Black Diamond City Council passed Resolution No. 143 adopting the proposed comprehensive sewerage plan prepared by the consulting firm of Brown and Caldwell.

In June, 1989, the state issued a finding of no significant impact for the City of Black Diamond facility.

On January 24, 1990, the King County Utilities Technical Review Committee met to discuss the proposed comprehensive sewerage plan and gave its recommendation for approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The City of Black Diamond 1989 Comprehensive Sewerage Plan is hereby approved subject to the following condition:

1 The portion of the sewer transmission main located outside  
2 the sewer local service area between the City of Black Diamond  
3 and the Soos Creek Sewer and Water District shall not be avail-  
4 able for any other connection unless it is consistent with the  
5 Tahoma/Raven Heights Community Plan, the King County Comprehen-  
6 sive Plan and the Sewerage General Plan. This condition shall  
7 be stated in any franchise and/or right-of-way construction  
8 permits for the sewer transmission main issued by the county.
