ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Vonderhofen to Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service only.

## STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Vonderhofen to Cedar River Water and Sewer District for water service was filed with the county council effective March 1, 1990.
- 2. Cedar River Water and Sewer District has found the petition for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolution No. 2700 concurred with the proposed annexation for water service.
- 3. Cedar River Water and Sewer District filed a Declaration of Non-significant Impact dated December 19, 1990, on the proposed annexation.
- 4. The county council held a public hearing on the 2nd day of April, 19 90 and has considered the criteria set forth in R.C.W. 57.02.040.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cedar River Water and Sewer District of the area known as Vonderhofen for water service and described in Section 4 herein is approved. This proposed annexation is consistent with R.C.W. 57.02.040 as described in the attached King County Council Annexation Report on Vonderhofen.

SECTION 2. Cedar River Water and Sewer District is the appropriate entity to serve the area proposed to be annexed for water service.

SECTION 3. Completion of this annexation does not constitute county approval or disapproval of any other permits, certifications, or actions necessary to provide service to this annexation area.

SECTION 4. The area known as Vonderhofen to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of the Northwest quarter and the Northeast quarter and the Southeast quarter of Section 22, and the Southwest quarter of Section 23, Township 22 North, Range 6 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the North line of the Southeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 22 with the Easterly margin of the City of Seattle aquaduct right-of-way;

Thence Easterly along said North line and the North line of the South half of the Northeast quarter of said Section 22 to its intersection with the Easterly margin of the Burlington Northern R.R. Co. right-of-way;

Thece Southerly and Southeasterly along said Easterly margin to its intersection with the South line of the North 327.72 feet of said Southwest quarter of Section 23;

Thence Easterly along said South line to its intersection with the East line of the West 659.44 feet of said subdivision;

Thence Southerly along said East line to its intersection with the Northerly margin of the Burlington Northern R.R. Co. right-of-way;

Thence Easterly along said Northerly margin to its intersection with the East line of the West half of said Southwest quarter of Section 23;

Thence Southerly along said East line to the South line of said Section 23;

Thence Westerly along said South line to the Southwest corner of said Section 23;

Thence Northerly along the West line of said Section 23 to its intersection with the Southerly margin of the City of Seattle aqueduct right-of-way;

Thence Westerly and Northwesterly along said Southerly margin to its intersection with the North-South centerline of said Section 22;
