

ORDINANCE NO. 9391

AN ORDINANCE relating to elections, changing the compensation provided election officials to conform with 1989/1990 changes in state and federal minimum wage standards; repealing Ordinance 918, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 1.08.020, and making a substitute thereto.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. Ordinance 918, Section 2, as amended, and K.C.C. 1.08.020 are hereby repealed, and the following substituted:

Inspectors and judges - Compensation. The manager, records and elections division, is authorized and directed to compensate election inspectors and judges at the following rates:

Activity:	Effective 7/1/89	Effective 1/1/90
Polling place staffing	\$ 59.67	\$ 65.86
Election official workshop	\$ 7.70	\$ 8.50
Inspector - transfer of ballots to election depot	\$ 19.25	\$ 21.25
Judge accompanying inspector to depot	\$ 3.85	\$ 4.25

Provided that at no time shall these rates, computed on an hourly scale, be less than either the state or federal minimum wage, whichever is greater.
