AN ORDINANCE initiating an Enumclaw park and recreation service area for the purpose of constructing a senior center; describing the boundaries of the proposed park and recreation service area, and ordering an investigation of the feasibility and estimated costs of the proposed park and recreation service area.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A. Formation. Under the authority given to the county by RCW 36.68.400 et. seq., a park and recreation service area within the boundaries identified herein is hereby initiated, subject to the following conditions: a determination of feasibility, one or more public hearings, and voter approval within the area described in Section 1.B of this ordinance.

B. Boundaries. The boundaries of the proposed park and recreation service area are as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Section 26, Township 21 North, Range 6 East; thence north to the intersection of the west line of Section 26 and the Green River; thence easterly along the middle of the Green River to its intersection with the east line of Section 25; thence north to the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 21 North, Range 6 East; thence east on the north line of Section 7 and 8, Township 21 North, Range 7 East to the southwest corner of Section 4, Township 21 North, Range 7 East; thence north on the west line of Section 4 to the northwest corner of said Section 4; thence east on the north line of said Section 4 to the northwest corner of Section 3, Township 21 North, Range 7 East; thence north along the west section line of Section 34, 27 and 22 to the northwest corner of Section 22, Township 22 North,

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Range 7 East; thence east on the north section line of Section 22, 23 and 24, Township 22 North, Range 7 East to the northeast corner of said Section 24; thence south on the east section line of Section 24, 25 and 36, Township 22 North, Range 7 East, and the east section line of Section 1 and 12, Township 21 North, Range 7 East to the southeast corner of said Section 12; thence east on the north section line of Section 18, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13 to the northeast corner of said Section 13, Township 21 North, Range 8 East; thence south to the southeast corner of Section 36, Township 21 North, Range 8 East; thence east to the northeast corner of Section 4, Township 20 North, Range 9 East; thence south to the southeast corner of Section 33, Township 20 North, Range 9 East; thence east to the southwest corner of Section 32, Township 20 North, Range 11 East; thence north to the northwest corner of Section 5, Township 20 North, Range 11 East; thence east to the summit of the Cascade Range; thence in a southerly direction along the summit to its point of intersection with Pierce County line; thence in a westerly direction along said county line to its point of intersection with the north line of Section 13, Township 20 North, Range 5 East; thence east to the southwest corner of Section 7, Township 20 North, Range 6 East; thence north to the northwest corner of the southwest quarter of Section 6, Township 20 North, Range 6 East; thence east to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 6, Township 20 North, Range 6 East; thence north along the west line of Section 5, Township 20 North, Range 6 East and the west line of Section 32 and Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 6 East to the centerline of the Green River; thence in an easterly direction along the said centerline of the Green River to the centerline of

Section 29, Township 21 North, Range 6 East; thence south to the south line of Section 29, Township 21

North, range 6 East; thence east to the northeast corner of Section 33, Township 21 North, Range 6 East; thence south to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 34,

Township 21 North, Range 6 East, thence east to the southeast corner of the northwest quarter of Section 34, Township 21 North,

Range 6 East; thence north to the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter of Section 34, Township 21 North, Range 6 East, thence east to the southwest corner of Section 26, Township 21 North, Range 6 East, true point of beginning, all situated in King County, Washington.

- C. Purpose. The purpose of this park and recreation service area shall be to construct a senior citizen activities center on a site owned by the City of Enumclaw.
- D. Estimated Costs. The estimated cost of construction, bond issuance costs and election costs is \$4 million. These costs are proposed to be financed through issuance of general obligation bonds to be repaid through excess property tax levies. Estimated operating costs for the first year of operation are not known at this time but shall be addressed within the feasibility study required in Section 2 of this ordinance.

SECTION 2. A report on the feasibility of the proposed park and recreation service area initiated in this ordinance shall be provided to the council no later than 80 days from the day this ordinance is adopted. This report shall address the feasibility of forming the proposed park and recreation service area, the appropriate boundaries of the park and recreation service area, an estimate and analysis of the costs proposed to be financed through sale of bonds, an estimate and analysis of the operating costs required for the first year of the

operation of the park and recreation service area, and other 1 issues germaine to the formation of this proposed park and 2 Within 20 days after receipt of the recreation service area. 3 report, the county council shall hold a public hearing and give 4 proper notice thereof in accordance with RCW 36.68.440. 5 Section 3.
