AN ORDINANCE establishing County, Seattle, and Suburban Cities Subfunds within the Open Space Projects Acquisition and Improvement Fund, and appropriating \$117,465,000 from the sale of General Obligation Bonds for the purposes of acquiring public green spaces, green belts, open space, parks and trails; and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 92, Attachments No. 1 and 2, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$117,465,000 to the Open Space Projects Acquisition and Improvement Fund for the items identified in Attachment No. 2 of this ordinance, from the sale of general obligation bonds for a new County Open Space Subfund in the amount of \$40,774,254, for a new Seattle Open Space Subfund in the amount of \$41,732,826, and for a new Suburban Cities Summary Subfund in the amount of \$34,957,920 for the purposes of acquiring public green spaces, green belts, open space, parks and trails.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 92, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

<u>CIP PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS</u> - From the several capital improvement project funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachments 1, as adjusted by Attachment No. 2, of this ordinance.
