ORDINANCE NO. **9443**

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the Rose Hill Water District 1982 Comprehensive Water System Plan.

PREAMBLE:

On April 21, 1989, a Declaration of Non-Significance was issued by the Rose Hill Water District.

On April 25, 1989, the Board of Commissions of the Rose Hill Water District passed Resolution 668, adopting an amendment to the Comprehensive Water System Plan.

On November 14, 1989, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendment and, finding it to be consistent with King County land use plans and policies and with Chapter 13.24 of the King County Code, recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The amendment to the Rose Hill Water District 1982 Comprehensive Water System Plan as set forth in Attachment A is hereby approved with no conditions.
