AN ORDINANCE relating to acquisition of open space, trail and park properties and amending Ordinance No. 2622, Section 7, as amended, and KCC 4.56.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2622, Section 7, and K.C.C. 4.56.060 as amended, are hereby amended to read as follows: Real Property Division - Responsibilities.

- A. Except as provided in this section. $((\mp))$ the real property division, acting under the supervision of the director, department of executive administration office, shall be the sole organization responsible for the administrative processes of acquiring, disposing, inventorying, leasing and managing real property, the legal title of which rest in the name of King County, or which King County manages in a trust capacity.
- B. Open space, trail and park properties shall be acquired by the office of open space of the department of parks, planning and resources, unless the executive directs the real property division to make such acquisitions.
- C. County departments shall be responsible for maintaining all real property for which they are custodian.
