ORDINANCE NO **9453**

AN ORDINANCE relating to surface water management; amending the number of citizens serving on the surface water management citizens advisory committee and their appointment period; amending Ordinance 7590, Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 9.08.030.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 7590, Section 4, as amended, and K.C.C. 9.08.030 are hereby amended to read as follows:

Surface Water Management Citizens Committee.

A. The surface water management citizens committee is hereby established. The committee shall act in an advisory capacity to the director on matters concerning surface water management and may submit independent recommendations regarding matters such as general program focus, program service levels and financing, and policies on surface water issues.

B. The committee shall be comprised of ~~((11))~~ twenty-five members who reside, ~~((or))~~ own property or have a community interest in the service area. At least four members shall live in cities which have mutual drainage interests with the county.

The committee members shall include a cross section of the public affected by the program including private citizens, commercial, community and environmental organizations.

C. The committee shall consist of ~~((eleven-(11))~~ twenty-five members appointed by the executive. ~~((from a list of names submitted by the council. One of the eleven members shall be an ex officio member representing the incorporated jurisdictions.))~~ The appointments shall be effective upon approval by council motion. Members whose terms have expired shall serve until replacements are appointed.

D. The appointments shall be ~~((for a period of three years and shall be staggered as follows: 4 members shall serve for 3 years, 4 members shall serve for 2 years and 3 members for 1 year))~~ effective until December 31, 1991.

1 ((E. ~~The appointments shall be effective upon approval by~~

4 ((F))E. The committee shall select its officers, including
5 chair, vice-chair and any others it deems necessary.

6 ((G))E. The committee shall adopt appropriate by-laws.
