

ORDINANCE NO. **9460**

1 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the granting of an electrical  
2 service system easement to Puget Sound Power & Light  
Company in Council District No. 7.

3 STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 4 1. By Ordinance No. 9338, King County recently vacated a portion of G.  
5 W. Foster Road (South 312th Street).
- 6 2. Puget Sound Power and Light Company has an electrical service system  
7 on that portion of the road which reverted to King County's Steel Lake Park.
- 8 3. Puget Power requires an easement for its system, and has requested  
9 that the county grant such an easement.
- 10 4. The natural resources and parks division and the real property divi-  
11 sion support the granting of this easement.
- 12 5. The King County council finds the rights requested by Puget Power are  
13 surplus to the county's present and foreseeable needs, including its need for  
14 park purposes.
- 15 6. The authorization for the granting of this easement was inadvertently  
16 omitted from Ordinance No. 9338.
- 17 7. The council of King County finds that granting this easement would be  
18 in the best interests of the people of King County.

19 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

20 SECTION 1. The county executive is hereby authorized to sign and deliver  
21 an electrical service system easement to Puget Sound Power and Light over,  
22 under, across, and upon the following described described property, situate in  
23 King County, Washington:

24 Those portions of the North 10 feet of the Northeast 1/4 of the  
25 Southeast 1/4 and the South 30 feet of the Southeast 1/4 of the  
26 Northeast 1/4 of Section 9, Township 21 North, Range 4 East, W.  
27 M, King County, Washington, lying Easterly of the East margin of  
28 28th Avenue South and lying Westerly of the West line of that  
29 certain 50-foot wide area identified as the landscape area on  
30 the West side of SR-5.
