

ORDINANCE NO. **9502**

AN ORDINANCE recognizing the use of \$491,151 from the temporary jail contingency in the department of adult detention for the costs associated with an environmental impact statement for the temporary jail and the salaries, furnishings, and operation of the jail planning team and the temporary jail transition team; expressing the intention that certain costs are to be reimbursed from future bond proceeds; and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 51, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The Council hereby recognizes the use of \$491,151 from the temporary jail contingency in the department of adult detention for costs associated with an environmental impact statement for the temporary jail and the salaries, furnishings, and operation of the jail planning staff and the temporary jail transition team.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 51, as amended is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ADULT DETENTION - The maximum number of additional FTEs for Adult Detention shall be increased by: 4.2

SECTION 3. The Operational Master Plan and Facilities Master Plan shall include review of the top five available sites recommended by the Citizens Jail Siting Advisory Committee (except the Cadman Redmond site will be substituted for the Leary Way Site) and shall include an EIS review of these sites and the adequacy of present facilities.

SECTION 4. Certain costs, included in Section 1, which are related to the activation of additional jail space, are intended to be reimbursed from future bond proceeds.
