2 AN ORDINANCE extending the deadline of the 3 temporary moratorium on the issuance of 4 building permits for facilities accessory 5 to a permitted public utility facility and conditional use permits for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and 6 7 appurtenances on Vashon and Maury Islands 8 9 and amending Ordinance 6765, Sections 1-4 10 and K.C.C. 20.12.327, and declaring an 11 emergency.

- BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
- 13 <u>SECTION 1</u>. Ordinance 6765, Sections 1-4 and
- 14 K.C.C. 20.12.327 are amended to read as follows:
- 15 Temporary moratorium Vashon and Maury islands.
- 16 A. Findings. The King County council finds that:
- 1. The location of radio frequency electromagnetic
- 18 transmitters and appurtenances are a public health concern to
- 19 the residents of Vashon and Maury Islands.
- 20 2. The department of parks, planning and resources has
- 21 begun a study of regulations governing the location of radio
- 22 frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances with
- 23 proposed regulations due for council consideration.
- B. Moratorium established. There is hereby established a
- 25 moratorium which prohibits the issuance of conditional use
- 26 permits as defined by K.C.C. 21.44.030 and building permits for
- 27 facilities accessory to a permitted public utility facility as
- 28 defined by K.C.C. 21.08.070 B in R, S, A-R, B, C, M, A, FR, and
- 29 QM zones for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters, and
- 30 appurtenances on Vashon and Maury Islands, provided, however,
- 31 that this moratorium shall not prohibit the issuance of such
- 32 permits for the relocation or replacement of existing radio
- 33 frequency electromagnetic transmitters owned and operated by
- 34 public police and fire agencies.

For purposes of this section the term "radio frequency 1 electromagnetic transmitters" shall mean any antenna, facility 2 or equipment designed to generate radio waves with the 3 frequency range of 3 MH, to 100 GH,. 4 5 C. Duration. The temporary moratorium shall be in effect until the King County council adopts revised regulations for 6 radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances 7 or ((June 30,)) December 31, 1990, whichever occurs first. 8 This time extension is made in anticipation that the county 9 executive will transmit the revised policies by June 1, 1990. 10 D. Implementation. All bonafide applications for 11 conditional use permits and building permits for public 12 utilities for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters, and 13 appurtenances pending as of the effective date of this section 14 shall be processed in the normal manner within normally 15 prescribed deadlines. However, no new applications for 16 conditional use and building permits as described in 17 subsection B of this section will be accepted by King County. 18

SECTION 2. The county council finds as a fact and declares

that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary

for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or
