ORDINANCE NO. **9514**

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District Water System Plan for provision to the Cedar River and Shadow Lake Elementary Schools.

PREAMBLE:

On April 5, 1990, the Board of Commissioners of the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District passed Resolution No. 0511-S adopting an amendment to the district's comprehensive sewer plan.

On April 11, 1990, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the proposed amendment and recommended approval.

On April 19, 1990, a declaration of non-significance was issued by the district.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The amendment to the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District adopted by the district in Resolution No. 0511-S is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: The sewer line between the Soos Creek Water and Sewer District's system and the Cedar River and Shadow Lake Elementary Schools shall not be available for any other connection unless such connection is consistent with the Tahoma/Raven Heights Communities Plan. This condition shall be stated in any franchise and/or right-of-way construction permits for the sewer line issued by the county.
