ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$448,374 from the unappropriated bond proceeds within Fund 313 to the Health Clinic Construction Projects for funding of the design phase of the North (Totem Lake) and South (Federal Way) health centers, and authorizing the Executive to proceed with a request for qualifications.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$448,374 to Fund 313, the Health Clinic Construction Fund from unallocated bond proceeds of Fund No. 313 to support the design portion of the following CIP Projects: No. 669017 - North Health Clinic (Totem Lake), \$273,133; No. 669019 - South Health Clinic (Federal Way), \$175,241.

SECTION 2. The Executive is authorized to proceed with a request for qualifications to obtain architectural design and engineering services for health clinic design, which includes new construction or renovation of an Eastgate facility as contract alternates. One of the alternates will be authorized by the County Council after approval of the budget and program plan for the Eastgate facility.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 8802, Section 92, Attachments 1 and 2, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:
