AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$64,910 to the Parks and Open Space Fund (309), for several CIP projects, from developer fees, and interest earnings accrued; and disappropriating \$24,614 from projects in the Parks and Open Space Fund 309 in the 1990 adopted budget, and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Sections 92 and 93, Attachments No. 1, No. 2, and No. 3 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$64,910 from developer fees and interest earnings accrued to the Parks and Open Space Fund (309) for the following CIP projects: \$14,910 to Brigadoon Elementary District, No. 009305; \$50,000 to a new Emergency Contingency, No. 309000; and cancellations of \$24,614 from the following CIP projects in Fund 309: \$13,358 from Shadow Lake Elementary District, No. 0098562; and \$11,256 from Lake Youngs Elementary District No. 009350.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 92, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

CIP PROJECT APPROPRIATIONS - From the several capital improvement funds there are hereby appropriated and authorized to be disbursed the following amounts for the specific projects identified in Attachments No. 1, as adjusted by Attachment No. 2, of this ordinance.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 93, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

5 Modified Scope Change Recommendation

6 Detailed design of both proposed baseball fields should be
 7 deferred. Several actions are required before the Council can
 8 make a final decision regarding development of these fields:

9 (1) The status of N.E. 138th St. between Juanita Drive
 10 and 84th Ave. N.E. must be finalized. Abandonment proceedings
 11 should be initiated immediately on this segment of N.E. 138th
 12 St. Abandonment may allow for better placement of these
 13 baseball fields in order to reduce the noise impact on the
 14 adjacent neighborhood. The design consultant should develop
 15 alternatives which minimize the noise impact of the fields.

16 (2) A plan for accommodating the amenities identified by
 17 the neighboring community should be developed. This plan
 18 should include a children's play area, a picnic area, tennis,
 19 basketball and/or volleyball courts. The plan should also
 20 identify methods of mitigating the noise impact of the
 21 existing fields.

1 Detailed design should not proceed on the two new ballfields
2 until the Open Space, Parks and Natural Resources Committee
3 reviews and approves the plan for amenities and sound
4 buffering.
