AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of

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revenues to the County Road Fund (Fund 103) to pay for flood related damages and 1990 surface water management charges; and waiving competitve bidding and minority and women's business enterprises requirments; and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 55, AND DECLARING AND EMERGENCY. On January 9, 1990 the County experienced a major rainstorm which resulted in flooding on the magnitude of a 100 year storm.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$1,925,423 to Roads-Operating in the County Road Fund (Fund 103) from Federal Emergency Management Agency grant revenues in the amount of \$1,389,042 and from Federal Highway Administration grant revenues in the amount of \$775,165 to pay for flood related damages in the amount of \$1,885,423 and King County surface water charges in the amount of \$40,000.
