

ORDINANCE NO. **9566**

AN ORDINANCE making a supplemental appropriation of \$1,925,423 from federal emergency management agency grant revenues and from federal highway administration grant revenues to the County Road Fund (Fund 103) to pay for flood related damages and 1990 surface water management charges; and waiving competitive bidding and minority and women's business enterprises requirements; and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 55, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

PREAMBLE:

On January 9, 1990 the County experienced a major rainstorm which resulted in flooding on the magnitude of a 100 year storm. This flooding resulted in significant damage to surface water management and roads facilities.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$1,925,423 to Roads-Operating in the County Road Fund (Fund 103) from Federal Emergency Management Agency grant revenues in the amount of \$1,389,042 and from Federal Highway Administration grant revenues in the amount of \$775,165 to pay for flood related damages in the amount of \$1,885,423 and King County surface water charges in the amount of \$40,000.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 55, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

ROADS OPERATING - From the County Road Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Roads Operating \$1,925,423

SECTION 3. In order to prevent delay in processing of contracts for repair of flood damaged facilities, pursuant to Motion No. 7816, construction contracts listed below are hereby waived from competitive bidding and Minority and Women's Business Enterprises requirements.

A. The following are hereby declared emergencies in conjunction with Motion No. 7816:

B. The ordinary requirements for competitive bidding of construction contracts pursuant to RCW 36.32 and formal solicitation requirements for professional/technical service consultant contracts and the purchase of tangible personal property pursuant to KCC 4.16 for such repairs in order to prevent delay in beginning such repair work are hereby waived.

C. The ordinary Minority and Women's Business Enterprises requirements pursuant to KCC 4.18 are hereby waived as to the individual project contracts, provided that compliance with minority and Women's Business enterprises requirements shall be met by the collective group of construction contracts as listed above in Section A.

SECTION 4. The county council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
