AN ORDINANCE waiving the competitive bidding requirements of RCW Chapter 36.32 for necessary alterations to leased facilities for the Pregnancy Research ("MOMS") Project due to the existence of an emergency in which the public interest would suffer material injury or damage due to delay, and <u>declaring an emergency</u>.

## Findings:

- The King County division of alcoholism and substance abuse services has contracted with the Washington State Department of Social and Health Services to design and operate a clinical treatment program for pregnant drug-abusing women.
- 2. On June 13, 1990 the consultation and construction review services section of the Washington State Department of Health gave King County approval to proceed with implementation of the project including specific approval of the facility alterations construction plans.
- The program contract agreement requires that no later than August 31, 1990 the delivery of treatment services must begin in a suitable facility for the project.
- 4. The lease for the facility is currently in the process of being executed by the parties and the division is assured that sufficient progress can be made to allow the program to commence delivering services if alterations are commenced by August 17, 1990.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County council declares that an emergency exists whereby the public interest would suffer damage or injury by delay if necessary alterations to facilities are not made to allow the program to commence delivering services no later than August 31, 1990 in that the contract for the Pregnancy Research Project might be cancelled as a result of delay in commencing services.

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SECTION 2. Pursuant to RCW 36.32.270 the requirements of 1 2 RCW Chapter 36.32 are hereby waived with regard to the contract or contracts for such alterations to the facility: provided, 3 4 however, that this waiver shall be effective only after execution of the facility lease and if appropriated funds are 5 available for the alterations. 6 7 SECTION 3.
