ORDINANCE NO. 9575

1
2 AN ORDINANCE waiving the competitive
3 bidding requirements of RCW Chapter 36.32
4 for necessary alterations to leased
5 facilities for the Pregnancy Research
6 ("MOMS") Project due to the existence of an
7 emergency in which the public interest
8 would suffer material injury or damage due
9 to delay, and declaring an emergency.

11 Findings:

12 1. The King County division of alcoholism and substance
13 abuse services has contracted with the Washington State
14 Department of Social and Health Services to design and operate
15 a clinical treatment program for pregnant drug-abusing women.

16 2. On June 13, 1990 the consultation and construction
17 review services section of the Washington State Department of
18 Health gave King County approval to proceed with implementation
19 of the project including specific approval of the facility
20 alterations construction plans.

21 3. The program contract agreement requires that no later
22 than August 31, 1990 the delivery of treatment services must
23 begin in a suitable facility for the project.

24 4. The lease for the facility is currently in the process
25 of being executed by the parties and the division is assured
26 that sufficient progress can be made to allow the program to
27 commence delivering services if alterations are commenced by
28 August 17, 1990.

29 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

30 SECTION 1. The King County council declares that an
31 emergency exists whereby the public interest would suffer
32 damage or injury by delay if necessary alterations to
33 facilities are not made to allow the program to commence
34 delivering services no later than August 31, 1990 in that the
35 contract for the Pregnancy Research Project might be cancelled
36 as a result of delay in commencing services.

1 SECTION 2. Pursuant to RCW 36.32.270 the requirements of
 2 RCW Chapter 36.32 are hereby waived with regard to the contract
 3 or contracts for such alterations to the facility: provided,
 4 however, that this waiver shall be effective only after
 5 execution of the facility lease and if appropriated funds are
 6 available for the alterations.

7 SECTION 3. The county council finds as a fact and declares
 8 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
 9 for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or
 10 safety or for the support of county government and its existing
 11 public institutions.
