AN ORDINANCE calling for a special election to be held on September 18, 1990, to submit to the voters of King County a proposition authorizing imposition of a county sales and use tax of one-tenth of one percent, in addition to any other taxes authorized by law, to be expended exclusively for criminal justice purposes, and DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. This ordinance is enacted pursuant to Washington Laws of 1990, 2d ex. sess., chap. 1, sec. 901. It is found and declared that an emergency exists requiring the submission to the voters of the County at a special election to be held therein on September 18, 1990, a proposition authorizing the imposition of a sales and use tax with a rate equal to one-tenth of one percent of the selling price (in the case of a sales tax) or the value of the article used (in the case of a use tax), which shall be in addition to any other taxes authorized by law, and shall be collected from those persons who are taxable by the state pursuant to chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW upon the occurrence of any taxable event within the county with the moneys received from such tax to be expended exclusively for criminal justice purposes.

SECTION 2. The manager of the King County records and elections division, as ex officio supervisor of all elections held in King County, is authorized and requested also to find the existence of such emergency and to assume jurisdiction of and to call and conduct such special election to be held within the County on September 18, 1990, and to submit to the qualified voters of the County at such special election the proposition set forth below. Clerk of the Council is authorized and directed to certify a proposition to the manager of King County records and elections division in substantially the following form:
