AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to the King County Water District 111 Comprehensive Water Plan for the extension of water service to the plat of Lakeridge.

PREAMBLE:

On December 28, 1989, a declaration of non-significance was issued by King County Water District 111 regarding an amendment to its 1978 Comprehensive Water Plan.

On March 23, 1990, the district's Board of Commissioners passed Resolution No. 251-03-90 adopting the amendment.

On April 4, 1990, the Utilities Technical Review Committee reviewed the plan and unanimously recommended approval.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The amendment to the King County Water District 111 Comprehensive Water Plan described in Resolution No. 251-03-90 for the extension of water services to the plat of Lakeridge is hereby approved.
