AN ORDINANCE authorizing condemnation of property for the Springbrook Regional Facility

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. The King County council, on December 21, 1988 by Ordinance No. 8802 and as amended, did adopt the 1989 Annual Budget for King County and did provide therein for the Capital Budget and Program, which included Surface and Storm Water Management Fund No. 318.
- 2. The King County Surface and Storm Water Management Construction Program did adopt and provided therein for the acquisition and construction of the Springbrook Regional Facility.
- 3. In order to acquire the property and property rights required to lay out and construct the regional facility known as Springbrook Regional Facility, it is necessary for King County to condemn certain lands and property rights and rights in property for public purposes as hereinafter more particularly set forth.
- 4. The King County council finds that the public health, safety, necessity, convenience, and welfare demand that the Springbrook Regional Facility be constructed in accordance with the Surface and Storm Water Management Construction Program, and that certain properties, property rights, and rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken, and damaged for the construction of said regional facility as provided in this ordinance.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the citizens of King County that the lands hereinafter described in the attached Exhibit "A," and other property rights and/or rights in property be condemned, appropriated, taken, and damaged for the purpose of constructing the Springbrook Regional Facility, subject to the making or paying of just compensation to the owners thereof in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 2. The King County council determines that condemnation proceedings are hereby authorized to acquire property and property rights and/or rights in property, for the purposes of subject conveyance system and drainage facility.

SECTION 3. The attorneys for King County are hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the proceedings provided by law to condemn, take and appropriate the land and other
