AN ORDINANCE establishing a vehicle registration fee for the purpose of funding general transportation improvements under the authority of Chapter 42, Session Laws of 1990 [Engrossed Substitute Senate Bill 6358].

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Under the authority of Chapter 42, Session Laws of 1990, Section 206(1), there is hereby levied an annual fee of fifteen dollars per vehicle for each vehicle that is subject to license fees under RCW 46.16.060 and is determined by the Washington department of licensing to be registered within the boundaries of the county.

SECTION 2. The fee imposed by this ordinance shall be collected and administered by the Washington department of licensing; the revenues from the fee imposed by this ordinance shall be distributed to the county and the cities; and the proceeds of the fee imposed by this ordinance shall be used strictly for transportation purposes in accordance with Chapter 42, Session Laws of 1990.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect six months after enactment.

SECTION 4. Should any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion
