AN ORDINANCE relating to taxation; imposing an additional sales and use tax upon and to be collected from those persons from whom the state sales and use tax is collected; fixing the rate of tax; and amending Ordinance No. 8325, Section 1 and K.C.C. 4.28.020, and adding a new section.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION 1. There is hereby levied an additional sales or use tax, as the case may be, as authorized by laws of 1990, 2d ex. sess., chap. 1, sec. 901 and 82.14 RCW, and by the voters of King County at a special election on September 18, 1990, that shall be collected from those persons who are taxable by the state pursuant to chapters 82.08 and 82.12 RCW upon the occurrence of any taxable event within King County. The tax shall take effect beginning November 1, 1990 and it shall expire January 1, 1994. The moneys received from such tax shall be expended exclusively for criminal justice purposes and shall not be used to replace or supplant existing funding.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 8325, Section 1 and K.C.C. 4.28.020 are hereby amended to read as follows:

The rate of the tax imposed by section 4.28.010 shall be one-half of one percent of the selling price or value of the article used, as the case may be.

The rate of the additional tax imposed by section 4.28.015 shall be onehalf of one percent of the selling price or value of the article used, as the case may be.
