

ORDINANCE NO. 9672

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$68,695 to the Public Health Pooling Fund from a transfer from the department of adult detention for inmate medical services at the King County Correctional Facility; and recognizing the use of \$68,695 from the temporary jail contingency in the department of adult detention to support the transfer to the Public Health Pooling Fund; amending Ordinance 9221, Section 70, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$68,695 to the Public Health Pooling Fund from a transfer from the department of adult detention for inmate medical services at the King County Correctional Facility.

SECTION 2. The council hereby recognizes the use of \$68,695 from the temporary jail contingency in the department of adult detention to support the transfer to the Public Health Pooling Fund.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

PUBLIC HEALTH POOLING - From the Public Health Pooling Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

King County Divisions \$68,695

The maximum number of additional FTEs for Public Health Pooling shall be: 1.54
