AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Housing Opportunity Fund modifying the method of securing the County's interest in projects from fee ownership to significant property interest, amending Ordinance No. 9368, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 9368, Section 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The purpose of the fund is to acquire, renovate and/or construct housing for low-income families, seniors at risk of displacement and homelessness, homeless individuals and persons with special housing needs by securing ~~((a-fee-ownership-interest-in-each-property))~~ a property interest in each project. Real Estate Excise Tax will be used to support the fund.
