2 AN ORDINANCE relating to local hazardous
3 waste management planning; adopting the
4 1989 Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan
5 for Seattle-King County as the hazardous
6 waste management plan for King County and
7 the cities that have signed the Solid Waste
8 Interlocal Agreements and adding a new
9 section to KCC 10.24

10 PREAMBLE:

11 The 1989 Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for
12 Seattle-King County was prepared in accordance with the
13 requirements of RCW 70.105 which requires each county
14 within the state, in cooperation with the various
15 cities located within such county, to prepare a
16 coordinated, local hazardous waste management plan.
17 King County is designated as the solid waste management
18 planning authority under the terms of the Solid Waste
19 Interlocal Agreement.

20 The 1989 Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for
21 Seattle-King County is prepared pursuant to King County
22 Ordinance 8098 and KCC 10.24.040. The final
23 environmental impact statement for the 1989 Local
24 Hazardous Waste Management Plan for Seattle-King County
25 was issued August 28, 1989.

26 The King County Solid Waste Advisory Committee reviewed
27 the 1989 Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan for
28 Seattle-King County and provided input throughout the
29 Plan's development. The Solid Waste Advisory Committee
30 submitted comments to the Solid Waste Interlocal Forum
31 on December 15, 1989, supporting Plan adoption.

32 On January 12, 1990, the Solid Waste Interlocal Forum
33 passed Resolution 90-001 recommending adoption of the
34 Plan with the amendments contained in the Plan
35 Addendum.

36 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

37 SECTION 1. The King County council finds the Seattle-King
38 County Local Hazardous Waste Management Plan Final
39 Environmental Impact Statement issued August 1989 is adequate
40 for purposes of making a decision to adopt the Local Hazardous
41 Waste Management Plan for Seattle-King County.

1 Section 2. There is hereby added to KCC 10.24 a new
 2 section to read as follows: The 1989 Local Hazardous Waste
 3 Management Plan for Seattle-King County as amended by the Plan
 4 Addendum of the Solid Waste Interlocal Forum Resolution 90-
 5 001, is hereby adopted.

6 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 22nd day
 7 of October, 1990.
