AN ORDINANCE authorizing the exchange of properties along the Fish Hatchery Road in Fall City, and declaring an emergency.

## FINDING OF FACTS

Peggy M. Blinco owns certain lands described as Parcel A.

Parcel A is necessary to King County for right of way along Fish Hatchery Road in Fall City.

King County owns certain lands described as Parcel B.

The King County council finds that Parcel B is surplus to King County's foreseeable needs.

The King County Council may authorize the executive to exchange county property in accordance with the provisions of K.C.C. 4.56.

It is recommended that Parcel B be exchanged for Parcel A.

The lands to be exchanged are deemed to be of equal value.

The department of public works, roads division has approved the exchange.

The King County council has determined it is necessary and in the best interest of King County that Parcel B be surplused and exchanged for Parcel A.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The King County council, having determined that the lands described as Parcel B in Attachment 2 are surplus to the needs of King County, does hereby authorize the King County executive to execute the necessary documents to exchange Parcel B for property owned by Pegge M. Blinco described as Parcel A in Attachment 1.
