ORDINANCE NO.

9708

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$295,556 to the Grant Fund for the Special Sex Offender Disposition Alternative Program and amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 74, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$295,556 to the Grant Fund from the Department of Social and Health Services, Juvenile Justice Section for a Special Sex Offender Disposition Alternative Program, Grant File No. 022/61.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 74, as amended, is hereby amended by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

GRANTS FUND - From the Grants Fund - Operating, additional funds are hereby appropriated to:

Provided that:

DYS shall establish a client tracking system to gather data on youth referred to the SSODA Program. The tracking system shall include at a minimum the following data:

1. Total number of offenders referred to the program, with a breakdown of type of sex offense by age and sex,
2. Total number of youth that have been referred to the program and have completed the program, and the number of re-offenders, with a breakdown of type of sex offense by age, sex, and length of time,
3. Total number of youth referred to the program who have not completed the program, the reasons for not completing the program, and the number of re-offenders, with a breakdown of type of sex offense by age, sex, length of time and outcome. This data shall be gathered on youth subsequently committed to DJR and on parole from DJR.

1 DYS shall submit to the Council by February 1, 1992 an
2 annual report, containing a summary of data from the tracking
3 system. An annual report shall be updated yearly and submitted |
4 to the Council by February 1 of each subsequent year.
5 DYS shall also submit a monthly status report to each
6 Councilmember and to the Health, Housing and Human Services
7 Committee.
