

ORDINANCE NO. 9709

AN ORDINANCE relating to transportation; adopting the 1990 Transportation Needs Report, amending Ordinance No. 9153, Section 1; and amending Section 4 to require public review in the annual review of the Transportation Needs Report.

PREAMBLE:

In accordance with the provisions of King County Ordinance 9153, Section 4; an update was conducted on the 1989 Transportation Needs Report incorporating community plan revisions, additional functional plan elements, other local and regional transportation plans and studies, and other information available to the county road engineer. The culmination of these efforts, the 1990 Transportation Needs Report, provides an updated list of transportation projects to act as a guide for the implementation of the King County Transportation Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 9153, Section 1 and K.C.C. 20.12.430 are hereby amended to read as follows:

A. The King County Transportation Plan consists of the following elements:

1. Policy Element, consisting of the transportation-related policies from the King County Comprehensive Plan 1985, and the transit/ridesharing/rail policy actions.

2. The arterial functional classification report.

3. The transportation priority process.

4. The ((1989)) 1990 transportation needs report.

5. The implementation strategy report, as amended.

B. The council finds that the King County Transportation Plan environmental impact statement is adequate to support adoption of the King County Transportation Plan.

C. The King County Transportation Plan, dated October 1989, is adopted as the functional plan implementing the transportation policies established by the King County Comprehensive Plan. As an amplification and augmentation of the King County Comprehensive Plan, it constitutes official county policy with regard to surface transportation issues.

D. The King County Transportation Plan's elements dealing with "Transportation Needs Report" and "Arterial Functional Classification" shall be subject to an annual review and update process preparatory to the capital

1 improvement program budgeting process. Updates shall incorporate community
2 plan revisions, additional functional plan elements, other local and
3 regional transportation plans and studies, and other information available
4 to the county road engineer((+)), and shall include public review and
5 information in the annual review of the updates. The department of public
6 works shall provide an update report to the executive and council on these
7 elements by May 31 of each year, identifying possible changes to the needs
8 lists or arterial classifications, and why these changes are needed.

9 E. The Transportation Plan shall be implemented through:

- 10 1. Adoption of an annual six year capital improvement program.
- 11 2. Application of the Road Adequacy Standards, K.C.C. Chapter
12 21.49.
- 13 3. Application of the mitigation payment system, when adopted.
- 14 4. Mitigation of transportation impacts as required and authorized
15 under the State Environmental Policy Act.
- 16 5. Road maintenance and traffic operating improvements.
- 17 6. Pursuit of additional funding sources at the local, state and
18 federal levels whenever possible.
- 19 7. Participation by the county in regional efforts to enhance bus
20 transit usage and development of a rail/high capacity transit system.
- 21 8. Establishment of a system for reviewing proposed developments
22 for their impacts on equestrian, pedestrian and bicycle traffic and requir-
23 ing mitigation when adverse impacts will occur.
- 24 9. Development of transportation system management techniques, zon-
25 ing code changes, and road improvements to enhance the use of transit and
26 increase vehicle occupancy.

1 10. Coordination of plans, projects, programs and policies with
2 other governments.
