AN ORDINANCE extending the deadline of the temporary moratorium on the issuance of building permits for facilities accessory to a permitted public utility facility and conditional use permits for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances on Vashon and Maury Islands and amending Ordinance 6765, Sections 1-4, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.327.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

ORDINANCE NO.

SECTION 1. Ordinance 6765, Sections 1-4, as amended and K.C.C. 20.12.327 are amended to read as follows:

Temporary moratorium - Vashon and Maury Islands.

- A. Findings. The King County council finds that:
- 1. The location of radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances are a public health concern to the residents of Vashon and Maury Islands.
- 2. The department of parks, planning and resources has begun a study of regulations governing the location of radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters and appurtenances with proposed regulations due for council consideration.
- B. Moratorium established. There is hereby established a moratorium which prohibits the issuance of conditional use permits as defined by K.C.C. 21.44.030 and building permits for facilities accessory to a permitted public utility facility as defined by K.C.C. 21.08.070 B in R, S, A-R, B, C, M, A, FR, and QM zones for radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters, and appurtenances on Vashon and Maury Islands, provided, however, that this moratorium shall not prohibit the issuance of such permits for the relocation or replacement of existing radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters owned and operated by public police and fire agencies.

For purposes of this section the term "radio frequency electromagnetic transmitters" shall mean any antenna, facility or equipment designed to generate radio waves with the frequency range of 3 MH, to 100 GH.
