- 2. The department of public works has notified the various utilities serving the area and has been advised that an easement has been obtained by Eastgate Sewer District.
- 3. The building and land development division has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 4. The department of public works notes that there is a drainage swale and system within a portion of the vacation area. The petitioners will be responsible for the continued existence and maintenance of the drainage swale and system.
- 5. The department of public works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicates that no public funds have been expended for its acquisition, improvement or maintenance. The road is, therefore, classified "C Class" in accordance with King County Ordinance No. 2759, as amended by Ordinance No. 3088.
- 6. The department of public works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the county road system and believes the public would be benefitted by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.
