SECTION 1. Swimming pool facilities (except King County Aquatics Center). Swimming pool facilities fees shall be:

A. Swimming pool fees (fees include sales tax) Public Swims: \$1.00 per person per session Sixty Cent Swims 60 per person per session Adult Only Swims 1.60 per person per session Senior citizens-60 years plus - \$1.00 per person for any

program session.

B. Swim lessons: \$100 per half hour to \$10.00 per half hour
