ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE establishing the date of an election on the question of annexation, zoning, and assumption of indebtedness to the City of Issaquah of an unincorporated area known as the East Sammamish Plateau.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

- 1. The City of Issaquah, Washington, by Resolution No. 90-21 adopted November 19, 1990, has requested that King County place on the February 5, 1991*special election ballot the proposal to annex a portion of the area known as the East Sammamish Plateau in accordance with Chapter 35A.14 R.C.W.
- 2. The number of registered voters within the subject area is estimated at 7238 as nearly as may be determined from available records, and has been certified as such.
- 3. Said resolution does satisfy the provisions of R.C.W. 35A.14.010 for qualification for annexation.
- 4. The City of Issaquah, by Resolution No. 90-3 adopted February 5, 1990, concurs in the annexation of the area known as the East Sammamish Plateau as provided by R.C.W. 35A.14.050.
- 5. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.93.100, the Boundary Review Board (BRB) invoked jurisdiction and in accordance with R.C.W. 36.39.160 on June 12, 1990, filed its written decision approving the proposed annexation as modified by the BRB.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A special election shall be held on the 12th day of March, 1991, in accordance with R.C.W. 35A.14.050 to be held within the territory of the proposed annexation, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters within said territory the questions of annexation, zoning, and assumption of indebtedness.

- SECTION 2. The ballot title, as directed by statute, should be substantially as follows:
- A. Shall the area as described in this ordinance of unincorporated King County commonly known as the East Sammamish Plateau be annexed to and be a part of the City of Issaquah and the zoning and land use regulations for the area as found in the City of Issaquah be adopted, and shall all property within the area, upon annexation, be assessed and taxed at the same rate and on the same basis as the property of the City of Issaquah is assessed and taxed to pay for all or any portion of the outstanding indebtedness of the City, including assessments

 Thence generally Southerly along the centerline of the Lake Sammamish to its intersection with the Northerly extension of the West line of the East 1210 feet of Gov. Lot 3 of Section 20, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.;

Thence South along said extension and West line to the South line of said Gov. Lot 3 and the city limits of Issaquah as established by Ordinance No. 759;

Thence East along said South line and city limits to the Southeast corner of Gov. Lot 3;

Thence South along said city limits to the Southeast corner of the Northwest quarter of said Section 20;

Thence East along city limits of Issaquah (being the North margin of SE 56th Street/NW Sammamish Road) as established by Ordinance No. 1144 to the West line of Section 21, Township 24 north, Range 6 East, W.M.;

Thence continuing East along said city limits to the West line of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of said Section 21 and the city limits of Issaquah as established by Ordinance No. 1675;

Thence North along said West line 645.24 feet to the North line of that area described in said Ordinance No. 1675;

Thence generally Easterly along the city limits of Issaquah to the West line of the East half of Section 21, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.;

Thence South along said West line and city limits to the north line of that area annexed to Issaquah as established by Ordinance No. 731;

Thence continuing in a generally Easterly direction along the North city limits of Issaquah as established by Ordinances 731, 1301, 714, 869, and 892 to the West line of the Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 27, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.;

Thence North along said West line to the South line of Section 22, Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M.;

Thence East along said South line to the SE corner of said Section 22;

Thence North to the Northeast corner of the South half of the South half of said Section 22;

Thence West along the North line of said South half of the South half of said Section 22 to its intersection with the existing Southeast margin of SE Issaquah-Fall City Road (Vaughn Hill Road) (Issaquah Road);

Thence Northeasterly along said road margin to the South line of the plat of Vaughn Hill Addition as recorded in Volume 102 of plats pages 99-100 records of said County;

Thence Easterly 12 feet and then continuing Northerly along the existing Easterly right-of-way line to the Northern most point of said plat of Vaughn Hill Addition, said point being also on the Southeasterly margin of SE Issaquah-Fall City Road (Duthie Hill Co. Road) (D.H. Thomas Rev. No. 2);

Thence Northeasterly along the Southeast margin of said SE Issaquah-Fall City Road to its intersection with the Southerly 2 extension of the Easterly margin of SE Duthie Hill Road (264th 3 Pl. SE) as located in the Northwest quarter of the Northwest 4 quarter of Section 13, Township 24 North, Range 6 East., W.M.; 5 6 Thence Northerly and Northeasterly along said extension and respective Easterly and Southeasterly margin of SE Duthie Hill 7 Road to the East line of the Northeast quarter of Section 12, 8 Township 24 North, Range 6 East, W.M. said point being also 9 10 the point of beginning.
