ORDINANCE NO. **9799**

3 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,160,884 to the County Road Fund  
4 (Fund 1030) to pay for flood related damages and 1990 surface  
5 water management charges; and waiving competitive bidding and  
6 minority and women's business enterprise requirements; and  
7 amending Ordinance No. 9221, Section 55, and declaring an  
8 emergency.

6 PREAMBLE:

7 On Friday, November 23, 1990, the Northwest was inundated by a severe storm.  
8 Record rainfall was recorded throughout Puget Sound. This rainfall resulted  
9 in significant flood damage to roads facilities.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of  
11 \$1,160,884 to Roads Operating in the County Road Fund (Fund 1030) to pay for  
12 flood related damages and 1990 surface water management charges, from Federal  
13 Emergency Management Agency grant revenues in the amount of \$1,033,776 and  
14 from Federal Highway Administration grant revenues in the amount of \$373,585;  
15 and waiving competitive bidding and minority and women's business enterprise  
16 requirements.

17 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 9221, Section 55, as amended, is hereby amended  
18 by adding thereto and inserting therein the following:

19 ROADS OPERATING - From the County Road Fund there is hereby appropriated to:  
20 Roads Operating \$1,160,884

21 SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares pursuant to  
22 Motion No. 8115 that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
