MOTION NO. **9822**

A MOTION relating to building security.

WHEREAS, in March, 1995, King County implemented interim emergency security measures to screen for weapons at the King County Courthouse and outlying district court facilities, and

WHEREAS, the county executive's proposal for a permanent building security program has been transmitted to the county council as the Phase I King County Building Security Plan, and

WHEREAS, the county executive's proposal continues the interim practices of screening all persons who enter the King County Courthouse, exempting employees in the District Courthouse and using contract employees for the weapons screening work, and

WHEREAS, the county council has determined that additional information is necessary before decisions can be made on a permanent building security plan;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The executive is requested to transmit to the council within 60 days of the adoption of this motion a revised staffing plan for weapons screening services that is within the cost estimate for that function, or as close thereto as possible, as provided for in the Phase I King County Building Security Plan. The revised staffing plan shall be based on the assumption that county employees will be hired to perform the weapons screening services.

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B. The executive is further requested to continue using contract employees to perform weapons screening functions, maintaining the status quo by screening county employees entering the courthouse, until such time the council provides final direction on this matter.
