

ORDINANCE NO. 9825

AN ORDINANCE approving an amendment to  
the Federal Way Water and Sewer District  
1983 Comprehensive Sewer System Plan.

PREAMBLE;

On August 24, 1990, the Federal Way Water and Sewer  
District issued a Determination of Non-Significance regarding  
an amendment to its 1983 Comprehensive Sewer System Plan.

On September 12, 1990, the King County Utilities Technical  
Review Committee met to consider the amendment and unanimously  
recommended approval.

On September 18, 1990, the Board of Commissioners of the  
Federal Way Water and Sewer District adopted Resolution No. 90-  
471, amending the district's 1983 Comprehensive Sewer System  
Plan.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Amendment No. 6 to the Federal Way Water and  
Sewer District 1983 Comprehensive Sewer System Plan adopted in  
Resolution No. 90-471 is hereby approved with the following  
conditions:

1. Sewer service to the area covered in the amendment  
shall be contingent upon the final approval of the plat of  
Forest Hills Estates.

1 2. All references to any "planning area" or "planned service  
2 area" shall be deleted from the text and maps of the amendment.
